

Itinerary in Brief

- Day 1:** Arrive Nairobi, transfer to your hotel, afternoon Kibera Creative Arts Tour, **Tamarind Tree Hotel (1 nt)**
- Day 2:** Depart by road for Lewa, afternoon game drive and welcome Sundowners, **Lewa Wilderness (2 nts)**
- Day 3:** Wildlife viewing, cultural activities, and behind the scenes visits to Lewa HQ & Operations
- Day 4:** Game drive transfer to Il Ngwesi, afternoon wildlife viewing, **Il Ngwesi Lodge (2 nts)**
- Day 5:** Full day of community & village visits, optional walking safari with overnight in a remote **fly camp**
- Day 6:** Continued wildlife discoveries, drive to **Lewa Wilderness (1 nt)**, farewell dinner & Lewa presentation
- Day 7:** Light aircraft transfer to Nairobi, visit to Sheldrick Animal Orphanage, transfer to NBO for departing flight
