Itinerary in Brief: 12 days / 11 nights

- Day 1** - Arrive in Nairobi and transfer to the **The Tamarind Tree Hotel** (1 nt)
- Day 2** - Train to Amboseli, game drive transfer to **Tawi Lodge** (3 nts)
- Day 3-4** - Two full days to explore the Amboseli ecosystem & learn about the *Big Life Foundation*
- Day 5** - Fly to the Masai Mara, transfer to Masai-owned & -operated **Tangulia Mara Camp** (3 nts)
- Day 6-7** - Two full days for wildlife viewing in the Mara with a presentation by the *Mara Predator Project*
- Day 8** - Fly to Lewa Downs Airstrip, game drive transfer to **Lewa Wilderness** (4 nts)
- Day 9-11** - Three full days to experience Lewa Conservancy with exclusive access to Lewa's programs
- Day 12** - Fly to Nairobi, visit attractions in Karen, day room hotel, transfer to NBO for departure

*Recommended extensions include **trekking with Mountain Gorillas in Rwanda**, extending your safari with a visit to the **Serengeti**, enjoying a few days of beach paradise on the **Swahili Coast**, or continuing on to **Victoria Falls** or **Cape Town** on the new Kenya Airways flights.*
